



Pennsylvania College of Technology’s Financial Aid Office processes Federal Stafford Loans on a “Scheduled Academic Year.” A Scheduled Academic Year dictates the frequency by which a borrower regains eligibility for annual Stafford loan limits. Summer semesters are considered “add-ons” to the year and are added to the beginning of Penn College’s Scheduled Academic Year. (e.g., Summer 2009, Fall 2009, and Spring 2010 would be an academic year.)

The charts below show the annual Stafford loan limits (maximum awards for a Scheduled Academic Year):

<b>Dependent</b>	<b>Annual loan limit</b>
Freshman Less than 30 credits earned	\$5,500 (\$3,500 between subsidized and unsubsidized, plus an additional \$2,000 unsubsidized)
Sophomore 30 or more credits earned toward an associate’s degree or 30 to 59 credits earned toward a bachelor’s degree	\$6,500 (\$4,500 between subsidized and unsubsidized, plus an additional \$2,000 unsubsidized)
Junior or senior 60 or more credits earned toward a bachelor’s degree	\$7,500 (\$5,500 between subsidized and unsubsidized, plus an additional \$2,000 unsubsidized)

<b>Independent (or dependent student with PLUS denial)</b>	<b>Annual loan limit</b>
Freshman Less than 30 credits earned	\$9,500 (\$3,500 between subsidized and unsubsidized, plus an additional \$6,000 unsubsidized)
Sophomore 30 or more credits earned toward an associate’s degree or 30 to 59 credits earned toward a bachelor’s degree	\$10,500 (\$4,500 between subsidized and unsubsidized, plus an additional \$6,000 unsubsidized)
Junior or senior 60 or more credits earned toward a bachelor’s degree	\$12,500 (\$5,500 between subsidized and unsubsidized, plus an additional \$7,000 unsubsidized)

*The following example should assist you in understanding how this new procedure affects your annual borrowing.*

Jane is a dependent, freshman student, with an annual loan limit of \$5,500 beginning Summer 2009.

Jane may borrow the \$5,500 as follows:

Over three semesters (*one option*):

- Disbursements of \$1,833\* for Summer 2009, Fall 2009, and Spring 2010

Over two semesters (*two options*):

- Disbursements of \$2,750\* for Summer 2009 and Fall 2009
- Disbursements of \$2,750\* for Fall 2009 and Spring 2010

Over one semester (*one option*):

- Disbursement of \$2,750\* for Summer 2009

If you wish to receive a Federal Stafford Loan for Summer 2009, you must have a completed 2009-10 FAFSA, be enrolled in at least six credits, and complete and return the Summer 2009 Federal Stafford Loan Request Form to the Financial Aid Office.

\* Amounts could vary depending on the number of credits you are taking and any fees your lender charges.

  - I have read the Summer 2009 Federal Stafford Loan Processing document and understand that requesting a Stafford loan for the Summer 2009 semester will reduce my eligibility for the Fall 2009 and/or Spring 2010 semesters.

Please process my Stafford loan as I have indicated below (*check one*):

- Summer, Fall, and Spring (*Three equal disbursements of the annual loan limit.*)
- Summer and Fall (*Two equal disbursements of the annual loan limit, no Spring 2010 eligibility.*)
- Summer Only (*One disbursement of half the annual loan limit.*)
