Duties and Responsibilities:

- Assist Maitre d' with uncovering, dusting, and maintaining the grand piano located in Le Jeune Chef Restaurant. (Essential)
- Take and play requests from Le Jeune Chef patrons. (Essential)
- Maintain a high degree of confidentiality with regard to any and all information as a direct or indirect result of job responsibilities/job functions. (Essential)
- Perform other appropriate job-related and general maintenance duties as requested by the Diningroom Manager. (Marginal)
