### **Key Databases**

#### **Books**

[WorldCat](#) - Here you will find books in our own library, as well as those you can borrow from other libraries.

#### **Articles**

[ProQuest](#) - Check the box labeled **Scholarly journals, including peer-reviewed** to limit your search to scholarly journals, and the Full-Text box to retrieve full-text articles only.

[JSTOR](#) - This full-text database of scholarly journals contains articles that are at least five years old—fine for papers in history or literature, but not for those in science or technology. Use the **Advanced search** feature and select the subject category of the journals you want to search.

[Historical Abstracts](#)-Although this database does have some full-text, mostly you will find citations to articles, rather than the articles themselves. If you want an article that is not full-text, copy and paste the **title of the journal** into [Journal Locator](#) to see if our library has an electronic or a print subscription.

### **Using the Library Catalog**

Use the catalog to find books and periodical titles, videos and other items that the Madigan Library owns on your topic. Try out these different ways to search:

1. Use [Power search](#):

You can limit to reference books, DVDs, etc, by choosing the appropriate format from the drop down menu in the **type** search box.

When looking for reference books, use more general search terms. For example, instead of **red scare** try **communism** or **political parties**.

**Help! I can't find any books on my topic!**

Ask a librarian to help you. You can IM us by adding **PCTLibRef** to your buddy list. You can also call us at 570 320-2409.

**Use Document Delivery to get books and articles from other libraries.**
