I. Use The New York Times Print Index (1851-)

Located on the second floor of the Madigan Library

The Year appears on the **Front of Each Issue:**

II. Use New York Times Article Archive (1851- present) [online](#)

1. Go to <http://www.nytimes.com/ref/membercenter/nytarchive.html>

2. Choose a range of years to search:

3. Type your search in the search box.

4. Click “Search”

5. Just below the search box is a link for:

[Sort by: Closest Match](#) | [Newest First](#) | [Oldest First](#)

Click on “Oldest First” to get to the early articles.
