

# Digital Photo Stitching Workshop

Saturday, February 16, 2008

In this workshop, participants will learn techniques to digitally stitch a series of photographs together to create a cohesive, panoramic image. While the images are reality-based, this technique creates an illusion of multiple perspectives. In actuality, a view of various angles would be impossible for the human eye to perceive.

This workshop will be taught by Gary Mesa-Gaido, Professor of Art at Morehead State University in Morehead, Kentucky. Mesa-Gaido's own works, which showcase this technique, will be on display at The Gallery at Penn College from February 19 – March 14, 2008.

The workshop will be held Saturday, February 16, 2008, from 9:30 to 11:30 on the campus of Pennsylvania College of Technology.
