- 1) Construction is the only goods-producing sector in which employment is expected to grow approximately 15% through the year 2012. There will be nearly 1 million new jobs for workers in the construction industries. (United States Bureau of Labor Statistics)
- 2) Construction jobs are good-paying jobs. In May 2005, seasonally adjusted hourly earnings in construction averaged \$19.37 per hour, 21% higher than the average for all private industry non-supervisory workers. (United States Bureau of Labor Statistics)
- 3) Construction is a major source of jobs. The industry provides employment to 7.2 million employees. From May 2004 to May 2005, construction employment rose by 278,000 employees, or 4%. (U.S. BLS) Future prospects are expected to be excellent, partially attributed to the booming construction market and baby boomers retiring.
- 4) The construction industry provides a variety of career choices, from equipment operators to project managers. The possibilities are limitless and can be as unique as the individual pursuing it.
- 5) You can decide on your working environment -Inside, outside, or both.
