Paramedic Program Uniform:

Uniform Shirt

- A dark navy Cornerstone Select Snag-Proof Tactical Polo shirt, model number CS410 (short sleeve) or CS410LS (long sleeve), with the words "Penn College Paramedic Student" embroidered on the left chest will be the required uniform shirt for all clinical/field rotations. This uniform shirt can be obtained from the college bookstore, and is the only shirt permitted. The uniform shirt must remain tucked into the uniform pants at all times.
- A plain white, dark navy, or black undershirt with a rounded collar must be worn at all times under the uniform shirt. In colder weather months, a white long-sleeve undershirt is permitted to be worn under the uniform shirt provided the sleeves of the undershirt do not extend beyond the sleeves of the uniform shirt.

Uniform Pants

- Uniform pants will be limited to EMS-Style navy blue cargo or straight-leg pants with a minimum belt loop size of 1 ½ inches. Cargo-style pants are preferred to facilitate the carrying of the required web-enabled tablet to field and clinical rotations. Pants must be clean, in good repair, and not faded. The following pants are approved for wear by students within the paramedic program, with any additional pants not listed requiring the approval of the program director:

Belt

- A black uniform belt of at least 1 ½ inches in width must be worn at all times with the uniform pants. The belt may be leather or web style and may not contain any ornate or obtrusive buckles.

Footwear

- Black leather boots, reaching above or covering the ankle, are to be worn with black laces in the field. Boots must be plain-toe style and must be clean and in good repair. The toes of the boots should be shined prior to attending field shifts. For clinical (hospital) shifts, black sneakers are to be worn.

Outerwear

- An appropriate EMS style uniform jacket is permitted to be worn with the clinical uniform. The jacket should be clean and in good-repair. Allowable styles will be either dark navy, black, or a high-visibility type jacket. The jacket must have either the approved Penn College Paramedic Student logo embroidered onto the left chest or attached to the left chest via the Velcro nametag. The nametag or embroidery must be sourced from the approved local vendor. Approved models include the following, with any other models requiring the approval of the program director:
 - Elbeco Shield Soft Shell Duty Jacket, Model SH3504
 - Port Authority Core Soft Shell Jacket (Black), model J317 (Black)
- Students may wear the approved navy Elbeco Shield Job Shirt, model #3730 with the words Penn College Paramedic Student on the left chest. Students may choose to have their first name embroidered on the right chest of the job shirt, but this is not required.
- Sunglasses are permitted provided the frame is of a single color and is not obtrusive. A solid blue or black neck cord is permitted.
- Navy blue or black knit cap or ear covering may be worn during periods of inclement weather.
- A Penn College baseball cap may be worn on field rotations.
