Additional Transfer Information

- Students must have gained admission to Penn College and met placement requirements.
- Penn College will accept Greater Southern Tier (GST) BOCES Heavy Equipment Certificate of Completion for Penn College credit for students who enroll at the College within two (2) academic years of graduation from Greater Southern Tier (GST) BOCES.
- Students must submit their final official transcript from their home sending school.
- Students must submit their official Greater Southern Tier (GST) BOCES Heavy Equipment Certificate of Completion for the two-year program.
- Penn College will only consider those credits earned through Greater Southern Tier (GST) BOCES for the terms of this agreement. Students must request transcripts from additional institutions to be evaluated on an individual basis at Penn College.
- Credits will post on the student's official academic transcript upon the successful completion of twelve (12) credits of academic work at Penn College. Prior to completion of twelve (12) credits, for advising and scheduling purposes, approved credits will show on working copies of the student's academic transcript and on the student's graduation profile. Whether Penn College credits will be accepted by another college or university is at the discretion of the receiving college or university.
