Policy:

- I. The Dean's List is announced by the Vice President for Academic Affairs & Provost at the completion of each semester. The list includes all matriculated undergraduate degree- and certificate-seeking students who earn six or more credits within a semester and have a semester grade-point average of 3.50 or higher.
- II. Students seeking a combined bachelor/master's degree who earn six or more credits within a semester and have a semester grade-point average of 3.50 or higher are also eligible for Dean's List.
- III. The following students are ineligible for Dean's List:
 - A. students seeking a master's degree or post-master's certificate;
 - B. students enrolled in non-degree status, including competency credentials and Penn College Dual Enrollment; and
 - C. students enrolled in workforce development programs.
