

**PATHWAY AGREEMENT BETWEEN
PENNSYLVANIA COLLEGE OF TECHNOLOGY
AND
ORANGE-ULSTER BOCES**

This agreement establishes a mechanism for students of **Orange-Ulster BOCES** to earn credit for the below defined coursework at Penn College in **Nursing (BGN/PBN)**, **Biomedical Sciences (BMC)**, and **Allied Health (AHS)**.

Additional Transfer Information

- Students must have gained admission to Penn College and met placement requirements.
- Students must complete coursework with a grade of C or better (2.0 or better on a 4.0 scale).
- Students must pass the Prometric New York Nurse Aide or Certified Health Professionals examination.
- Students must submit a copy of their Prometric New York Nurse Aide or Certified Health Professionals examination results to Penn College prior to enrollment.
- Students must submit a copy of their nurse aide or clinical medical assistant certification to Penn College prior to enrollment.
- Students must submit their final official **Orange-Ulster BOCES** transcript to Penn College prior to enrollment in order to receive credit for their **Orange-Ulster BOCES** coursework.
- Penn College will accept **Orange-Ulster BOCES** coursework for Penn College credit for students who enroll at the College within two (2) academic years of graduation from **Orange-Ulster BOCES**.
- Penn College will only consider those credits earned through **Orange-Ulster BOCES** for the terms of this agreement. Students must request transcripts from additional institutions to be evaluated on an individual basis at Penn College.
- Credits will post on the student's official academic transcript upon the successful completion of twelve (12) credits of academic work at Penn College. Whether Penn College credits will be accepted by another college or university is at the discretion of the receiving college or university.
