



While Pennsylvania College of Technology recommends that all students complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and the Master Promissory Note (MPN) for Subsidized/Unsubsidized Loans, note that students may choose to apply solely for a Private Alternative Loan without completing the FAFSA.

All financial aid including private alternative loan funds are to be used for the sole purpose of educational expenses. You cannot use your loan funds to pay for any non-educational expenses; for example, non-educational current or overdue bills, the purchase of a motor vehicle, or to make a vehicle payment.

Pennsylvania College of Technology requires all students receiving financial aid to sign a statement of Educational Purpose, which is included in the FAFSA. Since you will not complete a FAFSA, we need this statement on file before we can certify your loan. As with the FAFSA, **this form must be completed each academic year a student wishes to borrow.**
