

**PATHWAY AGREEMENT FOR HIGH SCHOOLS, CAREER TECHNOLOGY CENTERS (CTC), AND CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION (CTE) SENDING INSTITUTIONS BETWEEN**

**PENNSYLVANIA COLLEGE OF TECHNOLOGY**

**AND**

**MONROE 2-ORLEANS BOCES**

This pathway agreement establishes a mechanism for students of Monroe 2-Orleans BOCES to earn credit for the below defined coursework at Penn College in Diesel Technology (A.A.S), Electric Power Generation Technology: Diesel Emphasis (A.A.S.), Heavy Construction Equipment Technology: Caterpillar Equipment Emphasis (A.A.S.), Heavy Construction Equipment Technology: Technician Emphasis (A.A.S.), and Heavy Construction Equipment Technology: Operator Emphasis (A.A.S.), and Diesel Truck Maintenance (certificate).

**Additional Transfer Information**

- Students must have gained admission to Penn College and met placement requirements.
- Students must complete coursework with a grade of B or better (3.0 or better on a 4.0 scale).
- Penn College will accept Monroe 2-Orleans BOCES coursework for Penn College credit for students who enroll at the College within two (2) academic years of graduation from Monroe 2-Orleans BOCES.
- Students must submit final official Monroe 2-Orleans BOCES transcript to Penn College prior to enrollment in order to receive credit for their Monroe 2-Orleans BOCES coursework which identifies the completion of the Heavy Equipment Operations Program of Study/coursework.
- Penn College will only consider those credits earned through Monroe 2-Orleans BOCES for the terms of this agreement. Students must request transcripts from additional institutions to be evaluated on an individual basis at Penn College.
- Credits will post on the student's official academic transcript upon the successful completion of twelve (12) credits of academic work at Penn College. Whether Penn College credits will be accepted by another college or university is at the discretion of the receiving college or university.
