Additional Transfer Information

- Individuals must submit a completed Penn College application.
- Individuals must provide an **official** transcript of all college coursework.
- Students must have gained admission to Penn College and met placement requirements.
- Rosedale Technical College applicants must have a minimum final cumulative GPA of 2.0 (on a 4.0 scale).
- Students must complete a minimum of 36 credits at Penn College for coursework prescribed in the final four semesters of the student's baccalaureate curriculum, as provided in the [College Catalog](#).
- Students transferring to Penn College are eligible and will be considered for scholarship opportunities the same as currently enrolled students. Students must meet the application deadlines for scholarships for the fall and spring enrollment. Students must be accepted to the College to be eligible.
- Penn College will only consider those credits earned through Rosedale Technical College for the terms of this Articulation Agreement. Students must request transcripts from additional institutions to be evaluated on an individual basis at Penn College.
