

**Transfer Guide between  
Pennsylvania College of Technology  
and**

**Lancaster County Career and Technology Center – Adult Education**

This Pathway Agreement establishes a mechanism for graduates of Lancaster County Career and Technology Center (LCCTC) associate-degree programs to earn Penn College credit for the below defined bachelor-degree programs, all of which offer online/distance delivery options.

The following table provides the number of Penn College program-specific credits that *graduates* of the identified LCCTC programs will receive upon transfer.

Veterinary Technology AST – VET courses	<a href="#">Applied Health Studies</a>	47 BAH Credits

Automotive Technology AST – TRANS courses	<a href="#">Automotive Technology Management</a>	36 PTM Credits
Program-specific courses (VET, DEN, TRANS) from any of the three AST programs	<a href="#">Applied Technology Studies</a>	36 BAT Credits
Program-specific courses (VET, DEN, TRANS) from any of the three AST programs	<a href="#">Applied Management</a>	39 PTM Credits

In addition to the program-specific credits, students may be eligible to receive transfer credit for specific general education courses per Penn College’s Transfer Course Equivalency Database (<https://as400sec.pct.edu/CourseCrosswalk/>). At the present time, the courses below are listed as equivalent to Penn College course; that list may change over time and additional courses can be evaluated for equivalency upon request.

### **Additional Transfer Information**

- Individuals must submit a completed Penn College application.
- Individuals must provide an *official* transcript of all college coursework.
- Students must have gained admission to Penn College and met placement requirements.
- Students must have completed their associate degree with an overall GPA of C (2.0 on a 4.0 scale) or higher.
- Students must complete a minimum of 36 credits at Penn College for coursework prescribed in the final four semesters of the student's baccalaureate profile, a prescribed course sequence for completion of a specific major.
- Penn College will only consider those credits earned through LCCTC for the terms of this agreement. Students must request transcripts from additional institutions to be evaluated on an individual basis at Penn College.
