VETERAN BENEFITS

Most of our veteran students are using the Post 9/11 GI Bill™, known as VA Chapter 33, which **completely covers the tuition and fees at Penn College**. In addition to that, students receive a monthly housing allowance and a book and supply stipend of \$1,000 per year. We also offer credits for your military experience and training. Simply send your Joint Services or CCAF transcripts and we'll evaluate them for credit.
