DO THE RULES APPLY TO ME?

EPA's RRP Rule and HUD's Lead Safe Housing Rule apply to anyone receiving payment to perform work that disturbs paint in housing or child-occupied facilities built prior to 1978. This includes all firms and sole proprietorships.

- Residential rental property owners and managers
- ♦ Maintenance workers in multi-family HUD housing
