This Articulation Agreement establishes a mechanism for graduates of Harrisburg Area Community College, Associate of Arts in Social Services to transfer specific earned credits into the <u>Human Services</u> & Restorative Justice (HSJ) Bachelor of Science degree at Penn College.

Applicants must have a minimum final cumulative GPA of 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale).

 academic advising.
- Individuals must submit a completed Penn College application.
- Individuals must provide an *official* transcript of all college coursework.
